



e-AML2 enabling your digital pen account

Before you can complete e-AML2 forms using your Longhand Digital Pen solution you first need to register on the e-AML2 website. Please go to the home page of the e-AML2 website at <http://www.e-aml2.org.uk> and click the button for producer registration.

If you are already registered for the BPEX/FCI service the same username and password will work, however you still need to enable your Digital Pen Service.



Assurance Scheme Members:

1. Select the scheme to which you belong
2. Enter your assurance scheme number
3. Enter the postcode of the registered primary address for your membership



Non-assured Producers:

1. If you are **Non-assured** please enter the Herd mark or primo slap mark of the unit you would like to register
2. Enter the postcode of the site you would like to register.

If your details match a registered producer, you will proceed to the next screen. If no matching site or membership for the details can be found, then you will be asked to contact us for help in getting access.

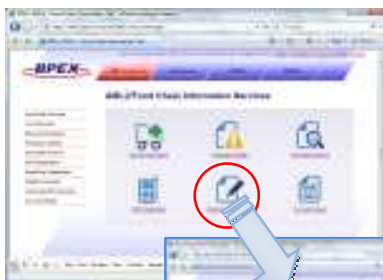


In the next screen, you need to provide your contact details so that a user account can be created.

Once you have completed both parts of the registration:

1. If your postcode and email address match our records, your pig unit details will be automatically added to your FCI account details.
2. If the postcode and email address details do not match our records, you will be contacted to verify your application.

Once you have received your log in details, you can log-in to the AML2 / Food Chain Information website using the log-in panel on the home page of the website.



You now need to select the Digital Pen Registration button and Activate your Digital Pen Service.
